Notice of Revised Date of Public Hearing

July 17, 2020

Rescheduled Hearing Concerning Proposed San Francisco Bay Plan Amendment No. 1-20 to Amend the San Francisco Waterfront Special Area Plan policies to Accommodate a Proposal to Moor the Historic Ship the Historic Ferryboat, *Klamath*, at Pier 9 in the Broadway Open Water Basin

On May 7, 2020, the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission voted to initiate an amendment to the *San Francisco Waterfront Special Area Plan*. The proposed amendment would address Bay Area Council's proposal to moor the historic ferryboat, *Klamath*, at Pier 9 on the San Francisco Waterfront. The initial descriptive notice adopted by the Commission set July 16, 2020 as the date for the public hearing on the proposed amendment. The hearing date was subsequently revised to August 20.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing on the proposed amendment **will be held instead on September 3, 2020**. At least thirty days prior to the initial public hearing, the staff will prepare and mail a staff report and preliminary recommendation on the proposed amendment. Interested persons may request the staff report and present written comments. Oral comments may be presented at the Commission meeting or thereafter as directed by the Commission.

This **Notice** is provided in conformance with Section 66652 of the California Government Code, Sections 11001 and 11004 of Title 14, Division 5 of the California Code of Regulations. If, after the public hearing, the Commission adopts an amendment to the *San Francisco Waterfront Special Area Plan* described in this notice and subsequent staff report, such amendment will be processed as a program change of the Commission's federally approved coastal management program for San Francisco Bay. Any federal agency interested, therefore, should provide comment to the Commission.

Whether the Bay Plan should be amended as described above, and in what manner, will be the subject of the public hearing and Commission deliberations.
