### **NOTICE OF FEDERAL CONCURRENCE OF ROUTINE PROGRAM CHANGE OF THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY SEGMENT OF THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

#### ***San Francisco Bay Plan Amendment No. 1-10***

***Amending San Francisco Bay Plan Map 3, Suisun Marsh Protection Plan Water-Related Industry Findings and Policies, Suisun Marsh Protection Plan Maps and Resolution 16 associated with the modification of the water-related industrial priority use area boundary at Collinsville in Solano County, California***

Pursuant to Section 923.84 of the federal Coastal Zone Management Act regulations, notice is hereby given that on November 22, 2011 the federal Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM) informed the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission that OCRM concurred that: (1) the revision of the *San Francisco Bay Plan Map 3, Suisun Marsh Protection Plan* (Marsh Plan) Water-Related Industrial findings and policies, Marsh Plan Maps and Resolution 16 associated with the modification of the water-related industrial priority use area designation at Collinsville in Solano County, California, constitutes a "routine program change" of the Commission's federally-approved coastal management program for the San Francisco Bay segment of the California coastal zone.

Notification was provided October 7, 2011 that the Commission was requesting OCRM's concurrence that this revision constitutes a routine program change and that comments on the request could be sent to OCRM. One comment was submitted by Ms. June Guidotti. OCRM staff considered this comment during their review process.
