**Location:** Within the 100-foot shoreline band, at the Belmont Sports Complex at 550 Island Parkway, in the City of Belmont, San Mateo County.

**Description: Within the 100-foot shoreline band**

Install four panel antennas (after-the-fact) 33-feet high on an existing 69 foot tall light pole at one of the baseball fields at the Belmont Sports Complex. The panel antennas connect by an underground cable conduit to four equipment cabinets on a 550-square-foot concrete pad surrounded by a wooden privacy/security fence. The telecommunications equipment was constructed between 1998 and 2011 without a permit.

**Location:** Within the 100-foot shoreline band, immediately south of Burma Road at Wharf 6 ½ (Berth 8), at the former Oakland Army Base in the City of Oakland, Alameda County.

**Description: Within the 100-foot shoreline band**

To replace infrastructure as part of the Oakland Army Base Redevelopment Project:

1. Remove a rail line, paving, and debris, and dispose of the material at an authorized upland location outside of the Commission's jurisdiction; and
2. Construct, use, and maintain an approximately 1,300-foot-long, 30-foot-wide portion of a temporary (for approximately 1 ½ years) bypass road to route traffic south of Burma Road during reconstruction of Burma Road.

This project will result in the construction of a temporary pedestrian/bike trail detour of a BCDC-required access trail in an area outside the Commission's jurisdiction near the intersection of Burma Road and Engineers Road.
