Location: In the Primary Management Area of the Suisun Marsh, at the intersection of Goodyear Road and Marshview Road, in an unincorporated area of Solano County.

Description: Install two approximately one-foot by four-foot antennae, a one-foot-diameter microwave dish, an approximately one-foot-long GPS antenna, and supporting routers, radios, cabinets, wiring, meters, and switches, all on an existing 38-foot-tall utility pole. The project would not involve fill in a managed wetlands nor does it propose public access.

- (2) placing, using, and maintaining steel sleeves around 45 creosote-soaked wood piles to repair them; and
- (3) relocating, using, and maintaining two piles.
