Location: Within the Primary Management Area of the Suisun Marsh, in an unincorporated area of Solano County, across Wells Slough, at UPRR Martinez Subdivision MP 44.95.

Description: Replace a railroad bridge by conducting the following activities:

1. Remove a 300-square-foot railroad bridge, including five pilings;
2. Construct, use, and maintain in-kind an approximately 1,200-square-foot pile-supported railroad bridge, including railings, supported by 18 piles, two approximately 48-square-foot concrete abutments, and four approximately 72-square-foot concrete wingwalls;

3. Remove approximately 145 cubic yards of soil from Wells Slough, thereby widening the slough from approximately 10 feet to 28 feet; and
4. Install, use, and maintain in-kind approximately 158 cubic yards of riprap at an approximately 2,850-square-foot area at the base of the abutments and wingwalls.

The project will result in a total of approximately 4,038 square feet of development in the Suisun Marsh.
