Location: In the Commission's Bay jurisdiction, within the Martin Luther King Jr. Regional Shoreline Park near Doolittle Drive, in the City of Oakland, Alameda County.

Description: Install, use, and maintain in-kind facilities to support recreational boating, specifically an approximately 3,000-foot-long buoy line, approximately ten one-square-foot anchors, associated cables, and approximately 50 buoys, and, around six months after installation, remove these facilities from the Bay. The project will temporarily result in approximately one cubic yard of fill within an approximately 90-square-foot area. No fill will remain in the Bay after March 31, 2018.

Location: In the Bay and within a water-related industrial priority use area designated in the *San Francisco Bay Plan*, at the NuStar Energy LP, west of the Carquinez Strait across of Mare Island, in the City of Rodeo, Contra Costa County.

Description: To comply with the requirements of the Marine Oil Terminal Engineering and Maintenance Standards (MOTEMS,) improve the existing wharf by:

In the Bay:

Install, use and maintain a hose tower structure and ancillary equipment including the installation of a 60.5-foot fixed boom crane on the top of the tower. The project will occur mainly within the footprint of the existing wharf. A stairway and landing will result in approximately 180 square feet of cantilevered fill over the Bay.
