This report lists the administrative permit applications, federal consistency actions, marsh development permits in the Secondary Management Area of the Suisun Marsh, statewide permit actions, minor amendments to the Suisun Marsh Local Protection Program, and emergency permits that are pending with the Commission. The staff members to whom the matters have been assigned are indicated at the end of the projects' description. Administrative Permits and Federal Consistency Actions

Location: In the Commission's Primary Management Area of the Suisun Marsh, at Lower Joice Island Club (Club #424), in unincorporated Solano County.

Description: Install three bulkhead structures (one 30-foot long, two 35-foot long) resulting in approximately 62 square feet and 10 cubic yards of solid fill, on the exterior side of a levee.

The project will not result in new public access, nor does it have the potential to adversely affect existing public access. The staff recommends that conditions of approval be incorporated for protection of marsh habitat and water quality, including requiring the permittee to employ construction best management practices and take other measures to avoid potential construction-related impacts to special status species and water quality.
