Location: In the Bay and within the Commission's Primary Management Area of Suisun Marsh, at the Grizzly Island Wildlife Area Crescent Unit, in unincorporated Solano County.

Description: Construct, use, and maintain in-kind an approximately 48-square-foot water control drain pipe with a stainless-steel flap gate with two 8-foot-long sections of exposed pipe (one in the Bay and one in the Marsh; each consisting of 0.17 cubic yards of fill), and one 24-foot-long section of pipe buried under the existing levee. The project is needed to improve the managed wetland water management capabilities at the Grizzly Wildlife Area Crescent Unit. No public access improvements are proposed as part

of the project, and the project does not have the potential to adversely affect public access. The staff recommends that the conditions of approval be incorporated for marsh protection, including use of best management practices and protection of special status species and water quality.
