And we have had an anchor out patrolling 10 feet off our docks the last two nights in the middle of the night clearly casing the neighborhood. We are so fed up with these people it's not even funny. Trash floating all over the bay, yelling and shouting at all hours of the night, you can tell things are getting very tense in that anchorage and it seems that despite Curtis' best efforts, there are constantly new boats showing up and so forth. Watching this 40 foot sailboat, tagged as Marine debris and brought in ten days ago, dragging anchor for over a quarter of a mile, undoubtedly ripping up the seabed, is heartbreaking.
