Hello, My name is [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] Union [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] to the police for people trespassing, I [REDACTED] been very quiet about the

happenings in Union Point Park. I cannot be quiet any longer. Things are getting out of hand. The illegal activity in the park, and the crime in the nearby neighborhoods as a result of the situation in the park is occurring on a much more frequent basis. We are having people climb the fence or go under it and come onto our property on a daily basis. Today we chased two people off the property and my employees are fearing for their safety when these individuals come on the property and start wondering around. Employees car windows have been shot out by BB guns as the individuals living in the park have said they are trying to shoot at the rats. We routinely find syringes from drug use that are thrown over the fence. In January, the Pump It Up across the street was broken into and the individual ran from there and onto our property assaulting someone in the process. After taking my statement, the police officer asked me what I would like to see happen. I told him that none of this would be happening if they cleaned up Union Point Park! I used to eat lunch in the park when I first came to Oakland. I loved it as it was peaceful and quiet. 5 years ago, I went into the park and I was immediately chased out by a belligerent homeless individual. I have not set foot in the park since. Now the belligerent aspect of the park is coming out to the surrounding community and it is harming everyone and causing people to be in fear of the area. My daughter is 9 years old. When she was between the ages of 4 and 6, we attended many birthday parties across from Miller Milling Company at Pump it Up. We have not been to another one since. Parents do not want to bring their kids to the area because of the element in the park which as I said is now an element in the entire community. Please police this park and bring it back to what it once was! Get rid of the criminal activity that is taking place in front of everyone! Thank you and I appreciate your time.
