
# GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- Social equity event for Design Review Board
- Commission briefings and workshops

# LONGER TERM EJ PROGRAM GOALS

- Integrate EJ into planning efforts (i.e., Seaport Plan and Regional Shoreline Adaptation Strategy)
- Address Tribal engagement and consultation
- Enhance community outreach and engagement to underrepresented groups
- Improve meeting and materials accessibility
- Integrate equity into BCDC's day-to-day activities
