Rick, it was good talking to you again. Just so there is no misunderstanding, I want to confirm our agreement:

1. The yellow lash barge at San Leandro Bay will be towed to an anchorage at Broad Slough, located between the Sac and SJ Rivers and owned by Winter Island Farms (a Duck Club, Bob Cologne president) who you pay for the use. The move will take place by July 25th and you will confirm with photos on July 26th.
2. The Oyster Pt docks that are stored at Pt San Pablo Yacht Harbor will be towed to Herman and Helens Marina at Empire Track Island by July 31st, confirmations photos to be sent the next day. The marina will replace their docks with your docks.
