Hi Anniken,


It is our understanding SaltRiver took the last barge of dredge material to Cullinan Ranch back on January 1, 2018 when work was completed. At some point recently, they returned with the barges and scow. Allan Shu from the City spoke to a representative from SaltRiver who said they would be moved within a few weeks.

1. Attached is a photo I took on Thursday 3-29-2018 at 11AM of the scow and barge with an excavator parked in Belmont Slough just outside the FC Intake channel (see attached location map). There was at least one person on the barge, and you could hear some type of engine running.
2. On the same day when I was crossing the bridge driving to the FC Intake/Sea Cloud Park at about 10:45AM I spotted a barge with an excavator in Belmont Slough at the approximate location I marked on the attached map.

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




Figure 2. USGS Topographic Map of the Project Area
