I will certainly try to come and speak again at the Enforcement Committee on November 20th regarding Union Point Park. My testimony will be very similar to my previous statement last month:

- 1: Union Point Park, along with many other portions of the Bay Trail, remains unusable by the public. It has been destroyed by homeless encampments with dozens of semi-permanent residents living there to the present time.
- 2: The City of Oakland and the Unity Council were granted Permits to maintain Union Point Park. They have failed to do so.
- 3: Joe DeVries of the City of Oakland stated at the previous Enforcement Committee meeting that the City has no plan and no timeline to remediate the situation nor to make the Park available to the public.
- 4: In a recent KTVU interview broadcast in late October, Mr. DeVries confirmed that the City will not remove tents nor tent residents from homeless encampments.
- 5: The City of Oakland and the Unity Council are in violation of their Permits and have been so for a long time. They have no strategy nor timeline to come into compliance. At the previous meeting, the Committee gave the Permittees five weeks to provide a plan and timeline.
- 6: If the City of Oakland and the Unity Council do not present a definitive action plan at the November 20th meeting, the Committee should immediately enforce monetary fines to compel the Permittees to come into compliance. If the Committee does not enforce monetary fines, they will have violated their own responsibility to protect the Bay.

Please share my comments with the Committee members and other concerned parties.
