- Senate Bill 1 Grant Program
 - Applications are accepted on a quarterly rolling basis
 - Noncompetitive
 - Next deadline is October 4
 - A technical assistance program is available to help EJ communities, tribal communities, and small and rural communities access funds
- Climate bond on the ballot this November
 - Will provide funding for cities and communities

Technical & policy assistance program goals

What should the program provide?

- Support for local capacity building to engage in adaptation planning
- Tools and data to support the development of Subregional Shoreline Adaptation Plans that meet BCDC's Guidelines
- Technical knowledge to select and advance the right adaptation strategies

Possible TA Mechanisms

- Templates, worksheets, how-to guides
- Online Mapping Data Portal
- Office hours, consultations, or ongoing partnerships
- Webinars/workshops
- Making tools accessible via a website
- Educational and training programs

How to guide what the TA program should become

- Ask end users what they need
- Ask community, elected officials, and others to clarify local needs
- Prioritize communities with the greatest need for support
- Identifying ways to make the TA program accessible and available widely


What will the Mapping Platform do?
