Purpose of This Report

The purpose of this report is to inform the Commission about new administrative matters.

- The Commission’s rules allow the Executive Director to take action on various administrative matters on behalf of the Commission. This report is provided for Commissioners and the public to learn about actions the Executive Director proposes to take or has recently taken.
- This report also details new planning and permitting matters taken by local governments in the secondary management area of the Suisun Marsh.

Pending Federal Consistency Review Requests

What is Being Reported Here:

The Executive Director acts on requests by federal agencies to approve [administrative federal consistency determination](#) requests. These requests are reported here to inform Commissioners and the public and to answer any concerns about the Executive Director’s determination that a consistency determination should be processed administratively.

The Commission has two options on how to proceed:

- If the Commission takes no action, the Executive Director will act on pending administrative federal consistency requests within the period established by the Coastal Zone Management Act; or,
- If a Commissioner objects to administrative review of these requests, and a majority of Commissioners agree, a hearing will be scheduled for the full Commission to review these matters.

Location: Within the Coastal Zone in subtidal and intertidal waters at Yerba Buena Island, in the City and County of San Francisco.

Description: The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) has submitted a proposal to repair and replace boat docks and associated facilities at the Coast Guard Station San Francisco. USCG has determined that repairs to the waterfront facilities at Station San Francisco are consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the enforceable policies of the San Francisco Bay Plan. The facilities to be repaired include small boat floating docks, the pier, wharf, and seawall. Repairs will not significantly increase bay fill or adverse impacts to the environment, and are planned for September 2026 to early 2028.
