Hearing concerning proposed San Francisco Bay Plan (Bay Plan) Amendment No. 1-26, an amendment of various sections of the Bay Plan to address beneficial reuse of sediment and soil for wetland restoration and rising sea level adaptation.

Notice is hereby given that the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (Commission) will consider an amendment to the San Francisco Bay Plan. The proposed amendment would address beneficial reuse of dredged sediment and upland soil for wetland restoration and rising sea level adaptation by evaluating several sections of the Bay Plan, including the *Summary* and findings and policies in *Fish, Other Aquatic Organisms, and Wildlife; Water Surface Area and Volume; Tidal Marshes and Tidal Flats; Fresh Water Inflow; Dredging;* and *Public Trust*. Additional information on the scope of the proposed amendment can be found within the Staff Report and Recommendation mailed April 24, 2026.

A Public Hearing on the potential amendment is scheduled to be held on August 20, 2026 at the regular BCDC Commission meeting starting at 1:00 P.M. Whether the Bay Plan should be amended as described above, and in what manner, will be the subject of the public hearing and Commission deliberation.

At least thirty (30) days prior to the public hearing, the staff will prepare and distribute a staff report and preliminary recommendation on the proposed amendment. Interested persons may request to receive the staff report by sending an email to the contact below and may submit written comments on or before August 20, 2026 by emailing publiccomment@bcdc.ca.gov. Oral comments may be presented at the August 20, 2026 Commission meeting or thereafter if directed by the Commission.
