Applicant: OneShoreline; Shores Business Center Association

Location: In the Bay, in Belmont Creek at Highway 101 near 101 Industrial Road and at Sem Lane near 1301 Shoreway Road, in the City of Belmont, San Mateo County.

Description: Limited sediment removal and wetland restoration on Belmont Creek.

BCDC Permit Application No. M2002.051.03

Applicant: City of Sunnyvale Water Pollution Control Plant

Location: In the Bay, at the NASA Ames Boat Ramp located on Cargill Salt Division property, in the City of Sunnyvale, Santa Clara County.

Description: Renewal of authorization to dredge up to 60 cubic yards of sediment per year from a concrete boat ramp with disposal at Sunnyvale Landfill.

Applicant: Carl Morabito

Location: Within the 100-foot shoreline band at 2314 Mar East Street in the Town of Tiburon, Marin County.

Description: Repair residential piers with marine grout and prefabricated fiberglass casing including four rectangular columns, four circular columns, and four horizontal beams, and install brackets to secure vertical beams to rectangular columns.
