### **Notice of Intent to Initiate Contra Costa County Resilient Shoreline Plan**

**Notice** is hereby given that the jurisdiction of **Contra Costa County** has formally initiated the development of a subregional plan which intends to conform to the guidelines in the Regional Shoreline Adaptation Plan (RSAP), as pursuant to Sea level rise: planning and adaptation, SB 272 (2023), and with the intent to seek approval from the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC).

The following information is intended to provide information for the public to understand the nature of the subregional plan and identify information on how to engage in the development of the subregional plan. In accordance with the RSAP, upon local adoption and submittal of the subregional plan to BCDC, the Commission staff will review the plan for completeness. If the submittal is deemed complete, an additional notice will be issued to establish a date for public hearing and vote for the Commission to approve the subregional plan. At least 30 days prior to the public hearing, the Executive Director will mail a staff summary and recommendation to the Commission evaluating conformance of the subregional plan with the RSAP.

**Plan Name:** Contra Costa County Resilient Shoreline Plan

**Jurisdiction:** Contra Costa County

**Project Description:** Contra Costa County is developing the Contra Costa County Resilient Shoreline Plan to proactively prepare for and respond to the impacts of sea level rise along the county's entire shoreline, focusing on unincorporated areas. The Plan will be consistent with the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission's Regional Shoreline Adaptation Plan (RSAP) and in compliance with Senate Bill 272. The Plan will be grounded in both science through a strategic update of existing vulnerability assessments and community priorities through an extensive community participatory engagement and visioning effort and robust input from local agencies and key stakeholders.
