Boston Green Ribbon Commission | *Organizational Structure*



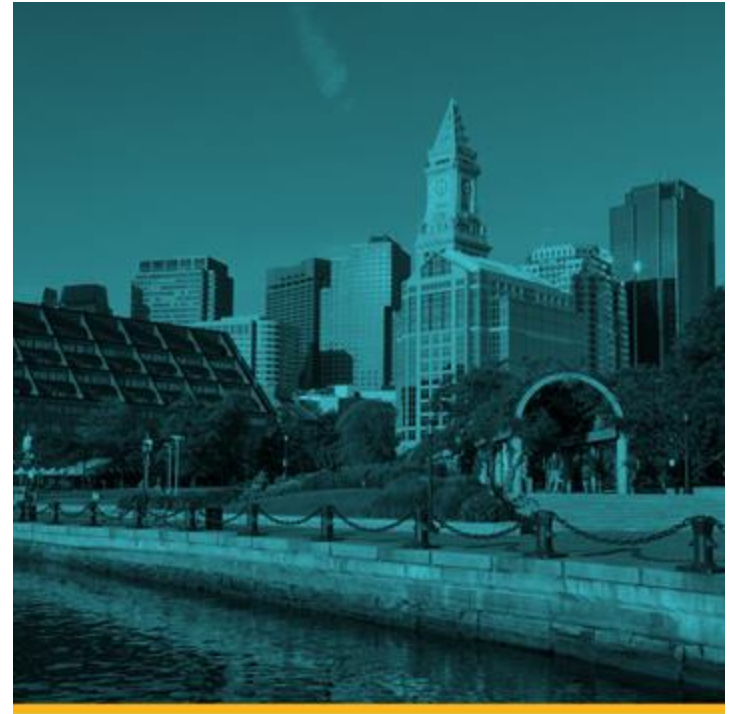

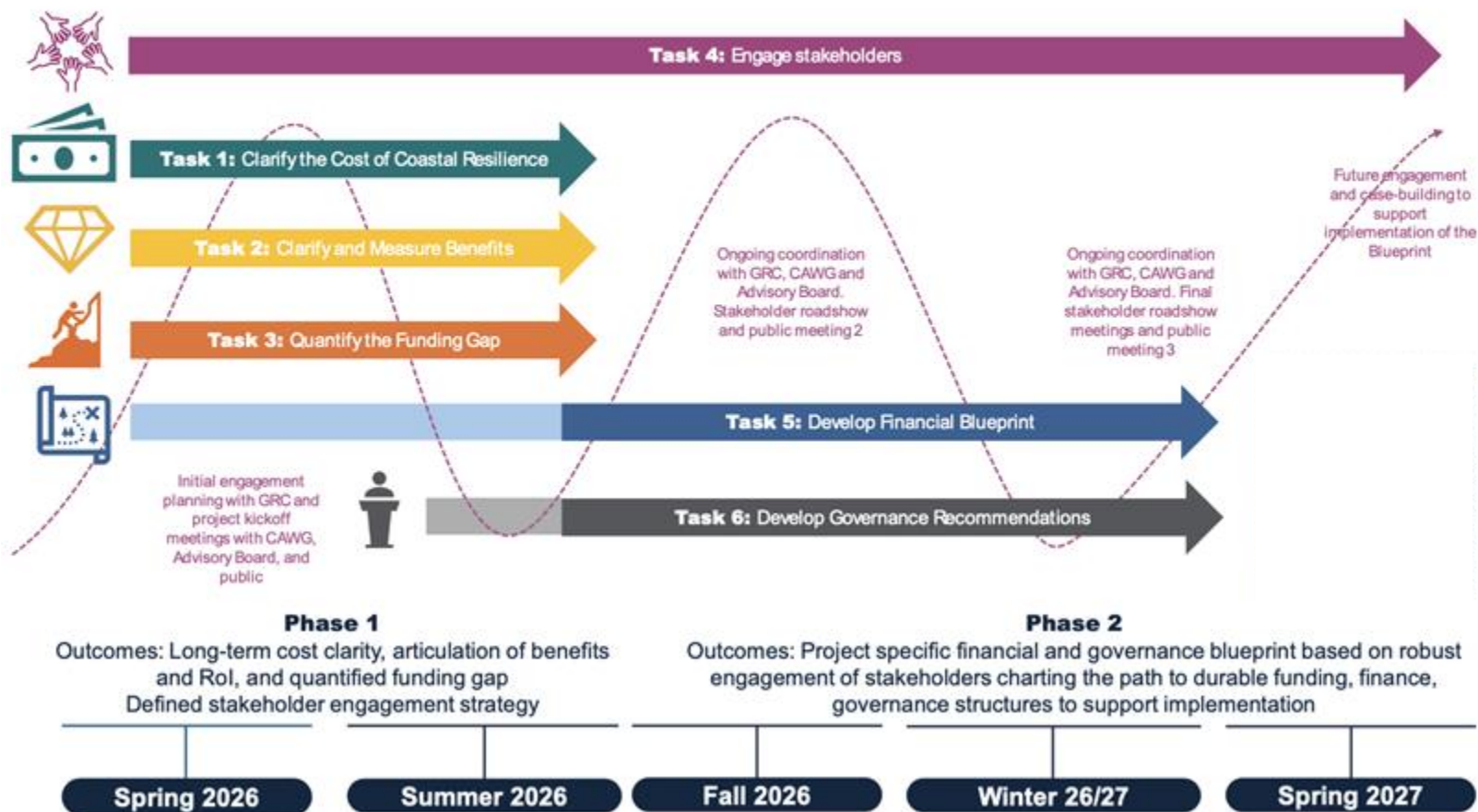

Timeline Overview

The Arcadis team estimates completing Phase 1 within 4 months, with 2 months of contingency to ensure we can complete within the 6-month requested window. The Arcadis team estimates completion of the overall project within 12 months, within 3 months float or contingency to ensure that we can complete the assessment satisfactorily within the 15-month requested window.
