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Notice of Revised Date of Public Hearing for Bay Plan Amendment No. 1-26

Mailed August 7, 2026

Rescheduled Public Hearing to October 15, 2026, concerning proposed San Francisco Bay Plan (Bay Plan) Amendment No. 1-26, an amendment of various sections of the Bay Plan to address beneficial reuse of sediment and soil for wetland restoration and rising sea level adaptation.

On May 7, 2026, the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC) voted to initiate an amendment to the San Francisco Bay Plan to address beneficial reuse of dredged sediment and upland soil for wetland restoration and rising sea level adaptation. The initial descriptive notice adopted by the Commission set August 20, 2026, as the original date for the public hearing on the proposed amendment.

Pursuant to section 11004(b) of BCDC's regulations, notice is hereby given that a public hearing on the proposed amendment will now be held instead on Thursday **October 15, 2026**, at 375 Beale Street in San Francisco, California, starting at 1:00 P.M at a regular BCDC meeting.

At least thirty (30) days prior to the initial public hearing, the staff will prepare and distribute a staff report and preliminary recommendation on the proposed amendment to all known interested parties, including those specified in sections 11003(a) and 11002(d) of BCDC's regulations. Staff will also post the staff report as part of the agenda materials for the October 15, 2026 hearing on BCDC's website. Interested persons may submit written comments up to the date of the public hearing. Oral comments may be presented at the October 15, 2026 Commission meeting. The staff report will include a response to written comments received up to the time the report is mailed. Any comments received after the staff report is mailed will be addressed as part of the final staff planning recommendation which will be distributed and posted in the same manner as for the initial staff report at least six days prior to the date of the scheduled meeting at which the Commission will act on the proposed amendment as required per section 11005(c) of BCDC's regulations.

This Notice is prepared in conformance with Section 66652 of the California Government Code and Section 11002 of BCDC's regulations.
